




What are EIP-AGRI Operational Groups

Operational Groups are financed at national and regional level and intended to **bring together multiple actors** such as farmers, researchers, advisers, businesses, environmental groups, consumer interest groups or other NGOs to advance innovation in the agricultural and forestry sectors.

Innovations - defined as

Innovation is "a new idea put into practice with success ... that may be technological, but also non-technological, organisational or social. Innovation may be based on new but also on traditional practices in a new geographical or environmental context. The new idea can be a product, practices, services, production process or a new way of organising things, etc. Such a new idea turns into an innovation only if it is widely adopted and proves its usefulness in practice."

General objectives

The main and long-term objective of GOFORESTS is to effectively share useful and easy-to-understand knowledge for the forest and agroforestry sector by developing a European multi-actor network to promote and disseminate in EU countries the best practices and other practical knowledge and results, related to the "innovation" of national/local forest and agroforestry EIP-AGRI OGs. This will promote the sustainability of private forestry and agroforestry (and rural areas in general) through new business models, social innovation, and climate change resilience measures. GOFORESTS provides intensive knowledge transfer activities to guide the formation of new alliances of farmers, foresters, policy makers, practitioners and other stakeholders in Europe to demonstrate the feasibility of alternative strategies and systems that are or could be funded at the local/national level by EIP-AGRI OGs.

Vision of the project


To address the Pact for Skills and Innovation in forestry and agroforestry according to emerging issues, GOFORESTS will work to create a large-scale EU partnership network between EIP-AGRI forest and agroforestry OGs. The GOFORESTS partnership network will work to ensure the efficient dissemination of best practices and results from existing OGs across the EU and to inspire the creation of new EIP-AGRI OG initiatives.

For key elements:

- 1. Establishment of five inter-regional Innovation topic Hubs (ITHubs) related to the five key priorities, and a Transversal innovation Hub (connecting the 5 ones) (IHub), to ensure that the existing knowledge and innovation reach forest and agroforestry in the EU
- 2. Facilitation of integrative knowledge exchanges across EU-borders using knowledge sharing platforms, identifying communities of practices and different modes of capacity building
- 3. Identification of lessons learned on strengths and weaknesses of EIP-AGRI OGs for policy makers at EU and national levels
- 4. Targeted outreach of relevant knowledge to maximise the impact






